- 1) Sole surviving US Navy Patrol Air Cushion Vehicle (PACV): Served in combat alongside 6665 – the “Ugly Duckling” in 1968 Perfume River Mobile Base One. PACV now owned by Yanks Air Museum, Chino, CA.
- 2) MKII, Kenner, LA (New Orleans) Purchased – for parts - by Dave Pizzoferrato one year after Hurricane Katrina. Hull was donated to a veterans group who wanted one for a static display. After selling hull 7329 and acquiring the Modutech hull from Larry Steever, all parts were transferred back to the Kenner group to complete the Kenner/Katrina PBR – one boat. It is now a static display at the Naval Memorial Park in Kenner. It had been formerly displayed at the Naval Reserve Base on Lake Ponchatrain. The Kenner group claims the hull number was 6829 but it had been cut out and no such markings were found when it was being stripped for parts.
